

TX3-WIEGAND-OUT Wiegand Output Module

TX3-WIEGAND-OUT mounts on the TX3 Lobby Controller Board on Telephone Access units and Touch Screens.


TX3-WIEGAND-OUT can be installed only on Telephone Access units that end in -A, -B or -C (for example, TX3-2000-4U-C). It can be installed on all Touch Screens.

A Telephone Access panel or Touch Screen with the Wiegand Output Module installed can send a facility code and a card code to a third-party access control system. The output sent is shown in the table below.

Event	Facility Code	Card Code
Access is granted by the resident after a visitor calls	167	Dial code associated with the resident
Access is denied by the resident after a visitor calls	168	Dial code associated with the resident
Access is granted by a keyless code	169	Dial code associated with the resident whose keyless code is used

Install the Wiegand Output Module

- Screw the four spacers to the controller board mounting holes.
- 2. Connect the ribbon cable to the P4 connector on the lobby controller board.
- 3. Place the Wiegand Output Module over the spacers, and then fasten into place using the four screws provided.



Wiring

1. Connect TX3-WIEGAND-OUT to your card reader system as shown below.



The maximum distance from TX3-WIEGAND-OUT to the access control system is 500 feet using 18 AWG, and 250 feet using 22 AWG. Mircom recommends a foil shielded multiple conductor stranded cable, at least 22 AWG. For example, use Belden 9535 or a similar cable.
